## **Special Post Event Andersonville Prison Presentation**

At 6:00 p.m. just prior to our October 21st meeting we are excited to have Lou Mallo as a guest speaker. His hour long presentation on the Civil War Confederate prison camp at Andersonville, Georgia will include many photo slides of this historic site. All Post and Auxiliary members are welcome to attend this special event.



Camp Sumter, commonly called Andersonville, was one of the largest military prisons established by the Confederacy during the Civil War. In existence for 14 months, over 45,000 Union soldiers were confined at the prison. Of these, almost 13,000 died from disease, poor sanitation, malnutrition, overcrowding, and exposure to the elements. The largest number held in the 26½-acre stockade at any one time was more than 32,000 during August of 1864.
